I write to request community project funding for the City of Glenn Heights Citywide Infiltration and Inflow Study Project in Fiscal Year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Glenn Heights, TX and the location is at 1938 S. Hampton Road, Glenn Heights, TX 75154. The project location would occur across the entire City of Glenn Heights. The funding would be used to fund a citywide infiltration and inflow study to identify specific areas that need capital improvements within the wastewater collection system. This is a valuable use of taxpayer dollars because it will allow the City of Glenn Heights to identify and narrow the scope of where the city should direct its resources to replace/repair damaged sewer lines within the community and move forward with capital improvements within the wastewater collection system. By replacing or repairing sewer lines that are pervious to ground/rainwater infiltrating the system, the City of Glenn Heights will also able to improve the quality of clean water while simultaneously lowering the costs it currently pays for wastewater treatment, thereby decreasing costs on residents' utility bills.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
