I am requesting funding for the **City of Hutchins – North JJ Lemmon Road Improvements Project** in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the **City of Hutchins, TX**, located at **400 J J Lemmon Road, Hutchins, TX 75141**. The funding would be used to widen North J.J. Lemmon Road to three lanes and improve the intersection at Langdon Road to better accommodate truck traffic accessing IH-20 and the Union Pacific Inland Port.
