I am requesting funding for **Paul Quinn College – Water and Economic Mobility Project** in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the **Paul Quinn College**, located at **3837 Simpson Stuart Road, Dallas, TX 75241**. The funding would be used to will implement a water capture and retention system to address severe soil erosion and protect critical campus infrastructure, including the Student Union building, roads, and parking lots. The project includes construction of a Gabion Retaining Wall and will provide a sustainable water source for the College's WE Over Me Farm, an urban farm that delivers nutritious food and workforce training opportunities for students and local residents.

This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it safeguards public infrastructure, ensures student and visitor safety, and strengthens the College's role as an educational and community resource.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(2).
